Cleaning/disinfecting of MA Lighting products

Proper surface cleaning is important to minimizing harm to the functionality of MA Lighting products. However, MA Lighting cannot advise which disinfection methods are effective against the COVID-19 virus. Please consider local requirements and authority advice.

Damage to the surface finish, painting or labeling may occur after frequent cleaning or disinfecting.

The use of alcohol solutions (70-80% isopropyl) does pose the least risk of causing damage to MA products if handled properly.

- Consider personal hygienic measures as advised by local authorities to minimize the contamination of your product.
- Protect yourself when cleaning and disinfecting your product.
- Never apply liquids directly onto the device's surface. Liquids may seep into the device and damage internal components. Apply cleaning liquid first to the cloth and then wipe down the surface.
- Use a dry non-abrasive cloth.
- Gently wipe and do not use excessive force.

The use of UV light solutions is an alternative disinfection method and does pose a low risk of causing damage to the MA product if handled properly.

- Irradiation with a 253.7nm UV-C light source at 150J/m² for a maximum of 5 minutes per 24 hours is permitted.

We do NOT recommend the use of following methods/substances as they have a higher likelihood of causing damage to the surface or other components of our products:

- Chlorine based liquids
- Peroxide based liquids
- High temperature
